Double down.

Double down.

If a player has a hand total of 11, what should they do against a dealer's 2 through 10?

Double down.

What should a player do if they have a hand total of 12 and the dealer shows a 4 through 6?

Stand.

What is the basic strategy for a player with a hand total of 13 through 16 against a dealer's 2 through 6?

Stand.

What should a player do if they have a hand total of 17 or higher?

Always stand.

What is the recommended action for a player with a soft 17 (Ace and 6) against a dealer's 2 through 6?

Double down.

What should a player do with a soft 18 (Ace and 7) against a dealer's 2 through 8?

Stand.

What is the basic strategy for splitting a pair of Aces?

Always split.

What should a player do if they have a pair of 8s against a dealer's 2 through 7?

Always split.

What is the recommended action for a player with a pair of 10s?

Never split.

What should a player do if they have a pair of 9s against a dealer's 2 through 6?

Split.

What is the basic strategy for a player with a pair of 2s or 3s against a dealer's 4 through 7?

Split.

What should a player do if they have a pair of 4s against a dealer's 5 or 6?

Split.

What is the recommended action for a player with a soft 19 (Ace and 8) against a dealer's 6?

Double down.

What should a player do if they have a soft 20 (Ace and 9)?

Always stand.

What is the basic strategy for a player with a hard 17 against a dealer's Ace?

Stand.

What should a player do if they have a hard 16 against a dealer's 10?

Surrender if allowed, otherwise hit.

What is the recommended action for a player with a hard 15 against a dealer's 10?

Surrender if allowed, otherwise hit.
