What is the basic objective of Blackjack?

The basic objective of Blackjack is to beat the dealer by having a hand value that is closer to 21 than the dealer's hand without going over 21.

What is a 'Blackjack'?

A 'Blackjack' is a hand that consists of an Ace and a 10-value card (10, Jack, Queen, or King) dealt as the first two cards.

What should you do if you have a hand value of 12 and the dealer shows a 4?

You should stand, as the dealer is likely to bust.

When should you always split Aces and 8s?

You should always split Aces and 8s to maximize your chances of winning.
