A blend is a group of two or three consonants that appear together in a word, where each consonant sound can be heard.
Can you give an example of a blend?
An example of a blend is 'st' in the word 'stop'.
What is the difference between a blend and a digraph?
A blend consists of two or three consonants that are pronounced together but retain their individual sounds, while a digraph is two letters that make one sound, like 'sh' in 'ship'.
List some common blends.
Common blends include 'br', 'cl', 'fl', 'gr', 'pl', 'sl', 'sm', and 'st'.
