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Part 1: Building a Foundation

Hint: Look for words that begin with the letter H.

- Hat ✓
- Apple
- Horse ✓
- Banana

■ The correct answers are A) Hat and C) Horse, as both start with H.

Write the lowercase form of the letter "H."

Hint: Remember how lowercase letters look.

The expected answer is 'h'.

List two objects you can find at home that start with the letter "H."

Hint: Think about common household items.

Examples could include 'hat' and 'house'.

What is the position of the letter "H" in the English alphabet?

Hint: Count the letters from the beginning of the alphabet.

The correct answer is C) 8th, as H is the 8th letter.

Part 2: Understanding and Application

What sound does the letter "H" make in the word "house"?

Hint: Think about the sound at the beginning of the word.

- /s/
- /h/ ✓
- /t/
- /m/

■ The correct answer is B) /h/, which is the sound H makes.

Which of the following sentences correctly uses words that start with "H"?

Hint: Look for sentences that have multiple words starting with H.

- The apple is red.
- The horse runs fast.** ✓
- The banana is yellow.
- The hat is on the table.** ✓

■ The correct answers are B) The horse runs fast and D) The hat is on the table.

Explain why the word "hour" does not start with the /h/ sound, even though it begins with the letter "H."

Hint: Think about how the letter H is pronounced in this word.

■ The expected answer should mention that 'hour' starts with a silent H.

If you are asked to find an object in a classroom that starts with "H," which would you choose?

Hint: Think about common classroom items.

- Desk
- Chair
- Hat ✓
- Book

■ The correct answer is C) Hat, as it is an object that can be found in a classroom.

Choose the words that would fit in a story about a "Happy Horse."

Hint: Think about words that relate to happiness and horses.

- Gallop ✓
- Sad
- Hay ✓
- Tree

■ The correct answers are A) Gallop and C) Hay, as they relate to a happy horse.

Write a short sentence using at least two words that start with the letter "H."

Hint: Think about how to combine words into a sentence.

■ The expected answer should include at least two H words, such as 'The happy horse hops.'

Part 3: Analysis, Evaluation, and Creation

Which word does not belong in the group based on the starting letter sound?

■ **The expected answer should mention that there are five H words and describe their roles.**

Which of the following would be the best title for a story about a hero whose name starts with "H"?

Hint: Think about titles that reflect heroism.

The Secret Garden

■ The correct answer is B) Harold the Hero, as it directly relates to a hero.

Evaluate the following words and choose those that could be part of a story about a "Haunted House."

Hint: Think about words that relate to haunted themes.

- Ghost** ✓
- Happy
- Spooky** ✓
- Light

■ The correct answers are A) Ghost and C) Spooky, as they relate to haunted themes.

Create a short poem or rhyme using at least three words that start with the letter "H."

Hint: Think about how to structure your poem.

■ The expected answer should include at least three H words in a creative format.
