The correct answers are A) Horse and C) House, as both start with H.
Describe the sound that the letter H makes. Provide an example of a word that uses this sound.

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The letter H makes a breathy sound, as in 'h' in 'hat'.

Hint: Think of common animals and objects.

The correct answers are A) The house is blue, C) He has a hat.
Create a short sentence using at least two words that start with the letter H.

The correct answer is B) House and Home, as they are related in meaning.
Identify the words that change meaning when the letter H is removed:
Hint: Think about how removing H affects the words.

The correct answers are A) Hat, B) Hen, C) Heat.

Analyze how the absence of the letter H in a word can change its meaning or pronunciation. Provide examples.

Hint: Consider words that lose their meaning without H.
