Describe the difference between a reflexIVE verb and a non-reflexIVE verb in Spanish, using 'lavar' and 'lavarse' as examples.

Hint: Consider how the action is directed in each case.

Choose the correct reflexIVE form of the verb 'acostarse' for 'we' (nosotros).

Hint: Think about the conjugation of the verb for the subject.

Identify the sentences where reflexIVE pronouns are used correctly in commands.
